CDE Rules

CDE Component	Points	Component Description
Individual scores from Wildlife or Aquatics CDE (Wednesday)	2000 pts	(500 pts possible per student)
Individual scores from Soils (Tuesday)	400 pts	(100 pts possible per student)
Team Event (Tuesday)	900 pts	All four members must participate in the preparation and presentation of the plan and answer panel questions. This will also include a score from the written proposal.
Total Points	3300 pt	

Causes for Disqualification:

- not in official dress
- less than 4 members
- using any printed materials or the internet to help create plan
- Use of electronic devices during the contest

Tie-breaker:

- Highest Team Event Points

Team Event Scenario:

- See PA FFA website for scoring rubric.
- All team members must be present in official dress to begin the team event.
- Team members will have access to a computer (no internet) for 1 hour to type a proposal based on the Scenario Topic.
- During that 1 hour time, members will also have access to materials needed to make a visual display to supplement their proposal and presentation.
- Team members will then present the proposal to a group of judges for a maximum of 8 minutes with additional 5 minutes for questions.

New for 2019 - ENR: Soil Component

- This component will take place on Tuesday before or after the team event (depending on when your team presents).
- This is an individual practicum.
- This portion will be worth 100 pts and will be added to the individual's score from the Wildlife or Aquatics CDE.
