Virtual CDE/LDE Rules

CDE Component	Points	Component Description	Virtual Platform
General Knowledge Exam Day 1	120	A 40 question exam involving dairy management practices and records. Participants will have 45 minutes to complete the exam.	A quiz in Google Classroom or similar testing system.
Five Judging Classes Day 2	250	Five classes of four dairy animals will each be placed on type. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Classes will be selected from the recognized dairy breeds. - The class selection committee will give priority to selecting quality animals for the contest and is not obligated to have all breeds represented. - Classes will consist of heifers, young cows or mature cows. - Each class is worth 50 points maximum for a correct placing. - Participants will have 15 minutes to place each class. <p>Oral Reasons</p> <p>Day 2</p>	<p>100</p>	<p>Oral reasons will be required on two classes.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - The two reasons classes will be identified prior to the evaluation of the class. - Oral reasons will be given at the conclusion of evaluating all five classes. - The use of notes during the delivery of reasons is strongly discouraged. Points may be deducted for the use of notes. - Each reason set is worth 50 points maximum. - Participants will be guaranteed a minimum of 20 minutes to prepare each set of oral reasons while waiting in the holding room. - No more than 2 minutes may be used to present reasons to the judge. 	<p>Zoom</p> <p>2 Main Holding Rooms, one for each set of reasons</p> <p>From each holding room, there will be two or three breakout rooms with a reasons judge. Students will be sent to the breakout room one at a time by the supervising individual/teacher.</p>
<p>Team Activity (Teams Only)</p> <p>Day 1</p> <p>2021 Topic – Young Stock Management</p>	<p>375</p>	<p>Each team will be provided with a dairy farm management scenario to identify problems and determine possible improvements.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - All necessary information will be provided, including but not limited to: Brief farm description, DHIA 202 Summary Sheet, and specific questions to answer. - Teams should assume the role of a hired consultant advising a dairy producer (judges). - It is not necessary to describe the scenario to the judges as they are the producer. - Teams are to use their existing knowledge to solve the scenario without access to written materials, books or internet. - Teams will be given 45 minutes to prepare their recommendations and 30 minutes to record and upload a 10 minute or less verbal presentation for the judges. - For the 2021 contest, judges will not be asking the student teams questions. - Team members are to wear official dress when recording their presentation. 	<p>Verbal presentation to be recorded and submitted for judges to review.</p>
