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### Basic Virtual CDE/LDE Guidelines

<b>Event Type:</b> Individual	<b># of Team Members:</b>
<p><u>Individual Materials List</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• 5 reference items must be printed materials such as books, magazines, or a compilation of collected materials in a binder but the pages cannot exceed 100 single sided or 50 double sided.</li> <li>• They cannot be speeches prepared by the participant or notes prepared for the purpose of this event.</li> <li>• <b>Individual computer with a camera and internet will also be required, remember you will be sharing your screen with the moderator and judges so make sure your environment and computer set up are school appropriate.</b></li> <li>• <b>You MUST be in official dress</b></li> <li>• <b>Stop-watches or timers are allowed during the presentation.</b></li> </ul>	<p><u>Group Materials List</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• N/A</li> </ul>
<p><u>Pre-Event CDE Expectations</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Familiarize yourself with potential speech topics that would fall into the 8 categories that are recognized by the National FFA.</li> <li>• Practice creating and reciting a 4-6-minute speech.</li> <li>• Practice using zoom and the share your screen feature</li> </ul>

		<p><b>placed in an individual Zoom room to prepare their speech (there will be a monitor in each zoom room during prep and speaking time).</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Topics will be selected at random</li><li>• <b>Topics will be numbered and participant will select 3 numbers.</b></li><li>• <b>The topics that have been assigned to those numbers will be presented to the speaker and they will select the one that they want to speak about.</b></li><li>• Participants will have 30 minutes to create a speech using their approved references.</li><li>• References will be checked, participants will show the moderator each of their 5 items and will be asked to verify that there are no prepared speeches or prepared notes for the contest. If the participant has any of these items they will be asked to remove them from their references.</li><li>• <b>At the beginning of the 30-minute prep time students will be able to use the internet as a reference source for 10 minutes, students must share their screen with the moderator during the internet prep time</b></li><li>• Participants will present their speech; the speech shall be no less than four minutes and no more than six minutes. Participants are allowed to have a stopwatch or timer during their presentation.</li><li>• After the speech a judge will have 5 minutes to ask related questions about the speech.</li></ul>	
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**Causes for Disqualification:** Not sharing the screen while preparing the speech and while utilizing the internet.

**Deductions:**

Deductions will be utilized when a student is over or under time.

**Tie-breaker:** Total of raw points.
