Virtual CDE/LDE Rules

CDE Component	Points	Component Description	Virtual Platform
Manuscript	200	PDF Version Emailed	None
Speaking	500	Present speech virtually to a panel of 3 judges at designated time.	Participant will be assigned a time to enter the Zoom meeting in a waiting room, at that point, they will then be moved to a breakout room with three judges, a time keeper, and the chair.
Questions	300	Answer questions for 3 minutes virtually with judges.	Judges will ask questions after speech for 3 minutes.

Note: It is highly recommended for the virtual competition of Junior Prepared Public Speaking that competitors sit in front of their computer to present their speeches. If they would like to utilize hand motions during their speech, that will be acceptable. If hand motions are excessive, the student could lose points on the score card, especially if it distracts from the presentation of the speech. If a competitor chooses to use a podium or stand to present their speech in order to incorporate movement, please be aware that sound

quality may be affected. The judges will not stop the competitor to let them know that their volume is not loud and/or clear, and this could affect their overall score.

Causes for Disqualification: none

Deductions:

Deductions will be utilized in the following areas: Late manuscripts and Under and Over Time

Tie-breaker:

- Ties will be broken based on the greatest number of low ranks. Participant's low ranks will be counted and the participant with the greatest number of low ranks will be declared the winner.
- If a tie still exists, then the participant with the lowest rank from the response to the questions will be declared the winner.
