

TRUE COLORS PERSONALITY TEST

In the first horizontal row of four squares, decide which group of three words seems most like you—and put a 4 in that square.

The group of words in that same row that seems next most like you will rate a score of 3, another group will get a 2, and the group which seems the least like you should be given a score of 1.

Then go on to the second horizontal row and score those squares in the same way: 4 for the group that's most like you, 1 for the group that's least like you, and a 2 and 3 for the ones in between.

Now add the numbers in each of the vertical columns and put the totals in these squares.


