Position 1: *Wildlife Management Intern*

The Pennsylvania Game Commission is looking to hire an intern for wildlife management and outreach. This internship will be varied due to the natural changes that happen with wildlife. One of the tasks will be completing wildlife surveys, including hands-on population monitoring and passive surveys. The intern should expect to work outside potentially in rain or snow and should expect hands-on, physical work. Interns should be adept at identifying tracks, scat, and other signs of wildlife. They should also be willing to travel to other counties when needed.

Position 2: *Chick-Fil-A Kitchen Team*

The local Chick-Fil-A is hiring a part-time kitchen team member. The candidate must be able to multitask, work at a quick yet efficient and thorough pace. The candidate should be team-oriented, dependable, and have a strong work ethic.
