

## SCORING RUBRIC

Rating: Score each section below with a 1,2,3,4 or 5. Total the scores and report on the tally sheet provided.
1 <u>Unacceptable response</u> : none provided, demonstrating a significant misunderstanding of the question, not meeting the criteria even to minimum extent
2 <u>Weak response</u> : meeting certain aspects to a minimum extent but fails in others, little evidence of ability to meet or deliver to the proposed criteria
3 Fair response: meeting the majority but not all aspects of the criteria, adequate evidence of ability to meet or deliver to the proposed criteria
4 <u>Good response</u> : meeting all aspects of the criteria, comprehensive, clear proposal demonstrating a good understanding of the criteria, clear evidence of ability to meet or deliver to the proposed criteria
5 Response which exceeds criteria: Materially exceeding the criteria, through a creative or innovative response or where additional 'additional areas have been identified, clear evidence of ability to exceed the proposed criteria
Project Benefits:  Quality of the proposed project, Clearly articulated benefits and defined beneficiaries Importance and relevance of the issue and the strength of the idea (the number and range of beneficiary) The degree of benefit The vulnerability of the target group Range of outcomes or outputs
Financial Need: Evidence the project has been devised on evidence of a clear and quantified need or demand

<ul> <li>Considering not only the costs of the project</li> <li>Are they reasonable?</li> <li>Are management costs or overheads high</li> <li>What other funding has been sourced, if any.</li> </ul>
<ul> <li>Clear evidence of how the project will meet at least one of the funding priorities, to:         <ul> <li>Offer a hands-on approach to students</li> <li>Improve the educational experience</li> <li>Help transform the curriculum</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
