<u>CDE Changes from Previous Years?</u> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Combine disorders, equipment identification, and wood products into one annual identification practicum worth 200 points (to match National CDE). Using the National FFA lists. • Change team activity to 400 points (to match National FFA) • Change the rotating practicum to 1 of 5 choices. (Map Interpretation, Compass, Chainsaw, 	

Forest Products, or Forest Business Management). This will then match the National FFA CDE changes.

CDE Rules

CDE Component	Points	Component Description
Written Exam	100	Test students' knowledge of general forestry information. The question bank is on the state FFA webpage.
Combined Identification Practicum	200	Disorders, equipment, and Products. Using the lists from nationals
Tree ID	150	From State list of trees
Timber Cruise	100	Diameter and Merchantable height using a Biltmore stick.
1 Rotating Practicum	100	Either- Map interpretation, Compass activity, Chainsaw, Forest Products, or Forest Business Management
Team Activity	400	A combination of the other non-tested practicums or skills used in forestry.
Causes for Disqualification: Use of cellular communication devices, identification apps, diameter tapes, or communication between team members during non-team activity events.		
Tie-breaker: Tree ID, Measuring, Written exam
